

Supply List for Watercolor Greeting Cards

A small watercolor set. A small field set of 12 or 24 is fine. Get the best one you can for best results. Have it ready to go at class time. You really only need the following colors:

Aureolin (yellow), Cad orange, Cad Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Sap Green, Cerulean Blue, Ultramarine Blue, and Burnt Sienna.

If you use tube paints, make sure they are squeezed into a palette ahead of time.

Three round watercolor brushes with good points, #8, #4, and #0 or #1 or a liner.

Water container, large.

Paper towels or Kleenex

Sharp Pencil

Kneaded Eraser

A roll of 1 inch blue painters tape.

An exacto knife.

A package of Watercolor Greeting Cards with Envelopes.

A permanent Marker, either an ultrafine Sharpie or a Micron Pen.

Old greeting cards that you love.

glue and dry glitter
