### **Desert Blossoms in Watercolor - Devon Meyer**

#### Watercolor Paper

140 lbs Arches or Fabriano, are all good ones. You may want to try both the hot press and cold press to see which you prefer.

Brushes: Good synthetic and synthetic blends. I use da Vinci cosmotop-spin Round sizes 6, 8 and 10 to start with!

#### Paint

I suggest you use professional grade paint. The student grade is less expensive, but the colors can vary too much from professional grade. Colors I Use:

French Ultramarine

Cobalt Blue

Cerulean Blue

Aliziron Crimson

Cadmium Red Light

Quinacridone Violet (optional color)

Cadmium Orange

Cadmium Yellow

Cadmium Yellow Deep

Raw Sienna and/or Yellow Ochre

Raw Umber

Burnt Sienna (Winsor Newton)

#### Photographs

It is best to paint from your own photos. Bring several reference prints of cactus and cactus blooms. If possible, bring each image in color and black and white

Miscellaneous Supplies • Watercolor palette—John Pike, or a small travel palette is good

- Large water container
- Board (one that push pins will stick into)
- Pushpins
- A rag or paper towels
